4. affirms he/she WILL return the leased Charter Halibut Permit, accompanied by the Annual CHP Activity Report, to the office of the Thorne Bay City Clerk, no later than November 1st of the calendar year in which it is leased.
5. understands that the Annual Activity Report is required to be submitted by the above-mentioned date, in order for the Association to remain eligible to hold CHP's.
6. understands that his/her failure to provide the Annual CHP Activity Report to the City Clerk by November 1st, may result in the Applicants ineligibility for leasing a CHP from the Association in the future.
