



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY,
ALASKA, AMENDING TITLE 16-SUBDIVISIONS, CHAPTER 16.32-
MONUMENTATION-VACATIONS-DEDICATIONS, SECTION 16.32.010-
MONUMENTATION


BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY,
ALASKA;

- Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is of a general and permanent nature, the chapter and section hereby adopted shall be amended in the Thorne Bay Municipal Code.
- Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- Section 3. Amendment of Section. The title and chapter of Title 16-Subdivisions, Chapter 16.32-Monumentation-Vacations-Dedications, Section 16.32.010-Monumentation, is hereby amended.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.

SUBDIVISIONS
Chapter 16.32
MONUMENTATION-VACATIONS-DEDICATIONS

Section 16.32.010 Monumentation. The exterior corners of the subdivision, and all corners of each lot within the subdivision, shall be monumented with a ~~three-quarter inch~~ ~~by thirty inch~~ **5/8" x 24"** pipe or bar capped and marked. If a plat corner or a lot corner is identical with a United States Survey, a United States Mineral Survey or an Alaska Tidelands Survey, the primary monument shall be shown on the plat, or reestablished and shown if not found.
