AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY,
ALASKA, AMENDING TITLE 13-UTILITIES, CHAPTERS 13.14-SEWER AND
13.48 WATER, SECTION 13.14.020-CHARGES PLACED ON BILL AND
SECTION 13.48.010-WATER SERVICE RATES

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY,
ALASKA

- Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature, the chapters and sections are hereby amended and added to the Thorne Bay Municipal Code.
- Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the circumstances shall not be affected.
- Section 3. Amendment of section. The title 14-Utilities, Chapters 13.14-Sewer and 13.48-Water, Section 13.14.020-Charges placed on bill, and Section 13.48.010-Water service rates is hereby added to the Thorne Bay Municipal Code.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.

Sections:

13.14.020 Charges placed on bill. All sanitary sewer service charges, except the connection fee, shall be placed on the bill for city water service charges and solid waste charges. ~~Customers receiving sewer service, but who do not receive water service shall be billed separately.~~

13.48.010 Water service rates. The water rates to be charged for each class of service, including minimum charges, charges for water used over the minimum and service connection charges, shall be as set forth in the most current water rate schedule adopted and approved by resolution of the city council and incorporated herein by reference. ***All customers who participate in water services and have city sewer connections must participate in sewer utility service unless otherwise approved by the department.***
