AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY,  
ALASKA, AMENDING TITLE 13-UTILITIES, CHAPTERS 13.12- SEWER,  
13.32-WATER, SECTIONS 13.12.040-FORFEITURE OF DEPOSITS, AND  
13.32.050-FORFEITURE OF DEPOSIT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THORNE BAY,  
ALASKA;

- Section 1.        Classification.        This ordinance is  
of a general and permanent nature, the  
chapter and section hereby adopted  
shall be added to the Thorne Bay  
Municipal Code.
- Section 2.        Severability.        If any provision of this  
ordinance or any application thereof to  
any person or circumstances is held  
invalid the circumstances shall not be  
affected thereby.
- Section 3.        Amendment of Section.        The title and  
chapter of Title 13-Utilities, Chapters  
13.32, and 13.12, Sections 13.12.040-  
Forfeiture of deposits, and 13.32.050-  
Forfeiture of deposit is hereby added  
to the Thorne Bay Municipal Code
- Section 4.        Effective Date.        This ordinance  
shall become effective upon adoption.

**Sections:**

13.12.040 Forfeiture of deposits. If an account becomes delinquent for sewer service, construction costs or a connection fee and it is necessary to terminate the water service, the deposit shall be applied to the unpaid balance due. Water service shall not be restored to those premises or that customer at different premises until all outstanding bills due the ~~department~~ **City** from the customer have been paid and the cash deposit is replaced.

13.32.050 Forfeiture of deposit. If an account becomes delinquent and it is necessary to turn off the service, the deposit shall be applied to the unpaid balance due. Water service will not be restored to these premises or that customer at different premises until all outstanding bills due the ~~department~~ **City** from the customer have been paid and the cash deposit replaced, together with a \$100.00 service charge as provided in Section 13.52.110.
