A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY, ALASKA SUPPORTING
THE RECOMMENDED ALTERNATIVE PRESENTED IN THE DOWL MAY 2017 PRELIMINARY
ENGINEERING REPORT FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City Council is the governing body of Thorne Bay, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the City has for the past 10 years been struggling to treat the water within the parameters set by the State of Alaska and the Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, the City has made water treatment upgrades a top priority and sought funding assistance since 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City of Thorne Bay has received some funding from Village Safe Water for upgrades and improvements to the water treatment process; and


WHEREAS, the City has contracted with DOWL to prepare a Preliminary Engineering Report that analyzes alternative upgrades and improvements to help reduce the disinfection byproducts that result from the current treatment process; and

WHEREAS, the recommended alternative from the draft report will meet ADE water treatment regulations; and


WHEREAS, the cost of the recommended alternative exceeds the funding allocation authorized by Village Safe Water,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the City of Thorne Bay hereby requests additional funding be allocated for final design and construction of the recommended alternative presented in the DOWL May 2017 Preliminary Engineering Report for the Water Treatment Plant Improvements.
