AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY, ALASKA,
AMENDING TITLE 3-REVENUE AND FINANCE, CHAPTER 3.04-FISCAL POLICIES,
ADDING SECTION 3.04.060 - GAMING ACCOUNT, DISPOSITION OF NET PROCEEDS
UPON DISSOLUTION OF ORGANIZATION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY, ALASKA


- Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature, the chapter and section hereby amended shall be added to the Thorne Bay Municipal Code.
- Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- Section 3. Amendment of Section. The title and chapter of Title 3- Revenue and Finance, Chapter 3.04-Fiscal Policies, adding Section 3.04.060 - Gaming Account, Disposition of net proceeds upon dissolution of organization; is hereby amended and added to the Thorne Bay Municipal Code.

Title 3 – Revenue and Finance, Chapter 3.04 – Fiscal Policies, **Section: 3.04.060 – Gaming Account, Disposition of net proceeds upon dissolution of Organization.**

A. Upon dissolution, any remaining net proceeds from gaming activity under AS 05.15 will be distributed to one or more existing permittees, other than a multiple-beneficiary permittee, in accordance with 15 AAC 160.020(a)(5).

- Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
