

NOTICE OF ELECTION & DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY METHOD

CITY OF THORNE BAY , ALASKA NOTICE OF REGULAR ELECTION

TO BE HELD: October 1, 2019

FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILLING THREE (3) VACANT SEATS ON THE THORNE BAY CITY COUNCIL.

SEAT: A 3-YEAR TERM – Term expires in 2022 (Currently held by Raymond Slayton)

SEAT: B 3-YEAR TERM – Term expires in 2022 (Currently held by Risa Carlson)

SEAT: C 2-YEAR TERM – Term expires in 2021 (Currently held by Mark Minnillo who was appointed to replace elected Councilman Robert Hartwell)

QUALIFICATIONS:

A person filing for election to a seat on the governing body must be:

- A. A United States citizen who is qualified to vote in state elections;
- B. A resident of the [specify city or borough] for thirty days immediately preceding the election for which declaring candidacy;
- C. Registered to vote in state elections;
- D. Not disqualified under Article V of the Constitution of the State of Alaska which provides that:

No person may vote who has been convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude unless his civil rights have been restored or judicially determined to be of unsound mind unless reversed.

FILING FOR OFFICE:

A person who wishes to become a candidate for an elective office shall complete and file with the Municipal Clerk a declaration of candidacy. This shall be filed **no sooner than 50 days** and **no later than 30 days** before the election. Any candidate wishing to withdraw his/her candidacy may do so no later than the last day for filing a declaration of candidacy (30 days before the election) by filing a written notice of withdrawal with the Municipal Clerk.

Candidates for office must file a declaration of candidacy with the Municipal Clerk not earlier than **MONDAY AUGUST 12, 2019**, and not later than **12:00 p.m., FRIDAY AUGUST 30, 2019**.

Declaration of candidacy forms may be obtained from the Clerk at the municipal offices from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. every Friday.

DECLARATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED ON WEEKENDS OR STATE OBSERVED HOLIDAYS.

The last day to file declaration of candidacy is **FRIDAY, AUGUST 30, 2019**

POLLS WILL OPEN: 8:00 A.M. OCTOBER 1, 2019

POLLS WILL CLOSE: 8:00 P.M. OCTOBER 1, 2019

LOCATION OF POLLS: City Hall Council Chambers, 120 Freeman Drive, Thorne Bay, AK 99919

Anyone wishing to vote by absentee ballot may do so by requesting an absentee ballot in person or by mail from the municipality. Absentee in person ballots may be requested no sooner than **Monday, SEPTEMBER 2, 2019**, nor later than **Monday, OCTOBER 1, 2019, BY 4:00 P.M.**

DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY FORM

I, _____, declare that I am a United States citizen qualified to vote in State of Alaska elections and am registered to vote therein. I meet or will have met the residency requirements of the City of Thorne Bay by the date of the election for which I am filing this declaration.

I am not disqualified as a voter under Article V of the Alaska Constitution, which provides in Section 2 that:

No person may vote who has been convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude unless his civil rights have been restored.

I declare myself a candidate for the office of City Council Seat:

- SEAT: A 3-YEAR TERM – Term expires in 2022
- SEAT: B 3-YEAR TERM – Term expires in 2022
- SEAT: C 2-YEAR TERM – Term expires in 2021

I request that my name be printed upon the official ballot for the municipal election to be held in the City of Thorne Bay, Alaska on the 1st day of October 2019.
