The SEARHC clinic will be the island's center for treatment but remember if you think you may be infected or have a fever and symptoms please call ahead first.

If you have a medical emergency, please let emergency services know you have symptoms when calling for assistance.

In the event of an emergency the official shelter for Thorne Bay is the Thorne Bay School. The school is currently **NOT** being used as a shelter. Residents are being strongly urged to stay at home unless there is a medical emergency.
