

Friends of the Thorne Bay Library is a non-profit corporation organized in the State of Alaska and also a 501 (c) 3 organization filed with the IRS. The Friends organized 20 years ago to support the Thorne Bay Library. Our main mission is to raise the matching funds for a new Library in Thorne Bay, so that the City does not have to pay this portion of the construction. The City has dedicated a piece of land on municipal property that will be the site of the future Library. While the Thorne Bay Public Library will always be a municipally owned and operated facility, the Friends assist in the day-to-day operations of the Library and help with major expenses.

The Friends of the Thorne Bay Library is a membership organization. Membership costs \$5 annually, and your membership dollars support the activities of the Friends. Membership is open to any person living in Thorne Bay, and we also welcome your participation in activities and fundraising events.

Friends of the Thorne Bay Library Board of Directors meets Quarterly at the Thorne Bay Library. Our meetings are in January, April, July and October. All of our meetings are open to the public, and the public is encouraged to attend our meetings.

Special thanks to Wayne Benner, who served as the City's Administrator for the last nine years and was instrumental in the initiation and completion of many projects within the City.


