RESOLUTION 21-03-16-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY, ALASKA, APPROVING THE RESTRICTION OF PARKING WITHIN THE SOUTH THORNE BAY SUBDIVISION, GOOSE CREEK INDUSTRIAL SUBDIVISION AND STEEP ROAD, WHERE POSTED, BETWEEN THE MONTHS OF NOVEMBER THROUGH MARCH 31ST EVERY YEAR

WHEREAS, the City Council is the governing body for the City of Thorne Bay, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, Thorne Bay Municipal Code 10.20.010 gives the Mayor authority to determine when and where parking, standing or stopping restrictions or exceptions are required within the City of Thorne Bay; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City, public safety, and public access to implement parking restrictions within the South Thorne Bay Subdivision, Goose Creek Industrial Subdivision & Steep Road; and

WHEREAS, the parking restriction shall become effective after adoption of this ordinance and all signage is put in place; and


WHEREAS, the provisions of this resolution shall not apply to the parking of any emergency vehicles such as Safety Officer vehicles, ambulances or fire trucks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Thorne Bay City Council for the City of Thorne Bay, Alaska, that no vehicle shall be parked, stored or left standing on any street or highway at any time between the months of November 1st through March 31st in each year wherever posted, within the South Thorne Bay Subdivision, Goose Creek Industrial Subdivision and Steep Road.
