

Thorne Bay Library Building Project

LATE SUMMER CONSTRUCTION UPDATE—September 2021

The New THORNE BAY LIBRARY is ready to ship in mid-September. The final inspection was August 19th and everything is ready to go. Volunteers have been working these past several weeks on the foundation and that is almost complete as well. The only thing left is the placing of the support beams under the building.

The modular building will be shipped the week of September 20th and the trailer and crane that will put the building in place will arrive in Thorne Bay the week of October 11th. We will be posting updates on the Friends of the Thorne Bay Library Facebook page, but we expect to place the building on the foundation on October 13 or 14th.

There is still work to be done. The utilities will need to be hooked up, the floor insulation must be installed under the building and the ridge cap will need to be put into place. Additionally—the carpeting will be shipped with the building and will need to be installed after the modular has been put into place.



We have been offered a CHALLENGE GRANT by an individual in Thorne Bay who will donate \$10,000 if we can raise the other \$10,000. We are close to reaching this goal with only a few thousand dollars to go!
