Press Release: 013, **FOUR (4) NEW** confirmed cases of COVID in Thorne Bay

For Immediate Release

Thorne Bay City staff was notified by Alaska Public Health on **SATURDAY September 4th** of **ONE (1) NEW COVID CASE** and notified on **WEDNESDAY September 8th** of **THREE (3) NEWLY CONFIRMED COVID-19 cases** in **Thorne Bay**, three (3) of the four (4) cases are considered secondary spread (direct contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19) and one contributed to travel. Public Health and the Alaska Division of Epidemiology are in the process of performing contact tracing and all persons who were in contact with the patient(s) are being notified.

There are currently **EIGHT (8) ACTIVE COVID-19** cases in Thorne Bay as of Wednesday, September 8th, 2021.

It is extremely important for all unvaccinated residents to continue to follow all health advisories to reduce the risk of spreading the virus in Thorne Bay. These measures include:

- Keep social gatherings small and maintain good social distancing at all times keeping at least six feet between non-household members.
- Wear a face mask/covering when in public settings.
- Wash your hands frequently and avoid touching your face as much as possible
- Do not share food with others
- If you have any symptoms of illness, even mild, contact your primary healthcare provider and self-isolate immediately
- Consider getting the COVID-19 vaccine. The vaccine is available for all residents ages 12 and older.

If you have been fully vaccinated (both doses of Moderna/Pfizer or a single dose of J&J vaccine plus two weeks), then you do not have to quarantine if you are identified as a contact of a positive case. You can contact SEARHC at 755-4800 or PeaceHealth Prince of Wales at 826-3257 if you are symptomatic, need testing for travel (or other testing needs), or want to sign up to be vaccinated.
