A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY CERTIFYING THE ELECTION RESULTS AND ALL PROCEEDINGS IN THE OCTOBER 4, 2022, REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City Council is the governing body for the City of Thorne Bay, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the City held a Regular Municipal Election on October 4, 2022, for the purpose of filling two (2) vacant council seats and voting on one (1) ballot initiative; and

WHEREAS, notice of the City Election was duly given per the Thorne Bay Municipal Code Chapter 2.28-Elections; and

WHEREAS, the City Council received from the City Clerk, a Canvass Report and Certificate of Results of the Regular Election ("Certificate of Election"); and

WHEREAS, there were a total of one hundred and two (102) votes cast and counted during the October 4, 2022, Regular Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THORNE BAY DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE AND CERTIFY AS FOLLOWS:


**Section 1.** That the minutes of the October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Council Meeting, reflect that the City Council certified the Election Results, reflecting a total of 102 votes cast, counted and reflected in the Certificate of the Election.

**Section 2.** That all proceedings in connection with the Regular Municipal Election have been accomplished according to law and the City Clerk is, hereby authorized and directed to deliver, or arrange for delivery of, a copy of the Certificate of Election to each newly elected councilmember.

ORDINANCE 22-10-10-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY, ALASKA, ADOPTING TERM LIMITS FOR ELECTIVE CITY OFFICES, BY AMENDING TITLE 2-ADMINISTRATION & PERSONNEL; CHAPTER 2.04-CITY COUNCIL; ADDING SECTION 2.04.035 TERM LIMITS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE VOTERS FOR THE CITY OF THORNE BAY, ALASKA

**Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature, the chapter and section hereby amended shall be added to the Thorne Bay Municipal Code if approved by the majority of the voters at the October 4, 2022, Regular Municipal Election.

**Section 2. Severability.** If any provisions of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3. Amendment of Section.** The title and chapter of Title 2-Administration and Personnel, Chapter 2.04-City Council; Section 2.04.035-Term Limits; is hereby amended and shall be added to the Thorne Bay City Code and read as follow:

**CHAPTER 2.04 – CITY COUNCIL.**

**2.04.035. Term limits.** A person shall serve no more than two, three-year terms, or six consecutive years in office as a City Councilmember, provided however, that such person shall be eligible to hold such office after a break in service of thirty-six months.

- a) A full term in office of the City Council is three years.
- b) If any Councilmember has served 4 consecutive years in when their term has expired, they may only apply for and be elected to a seat that has a term of 1 to 2 years, so not to exceed the maximum of 6 consecutive years in office.

**Section 4. Adoption.** Pursuant to the Alaska Statutes 29.26, this Ordinance shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Thorne Bay at the regularly scheduled election of October 4, 2022 and shall only become effective if a majority of

votes cast on the question of whether to adopt this ordinance favor adoption of this ordinance.

Section 5. Intent & Interpretation. The City Council and the voters intend that an individual's previous and current terms of office shall be counted for the purpose of applying the term limits adopted herein, although all persons in office on the effective date of this Ordinance shall be permitted to complete their then-current terms.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon ratification by the voters of Thorne Bay. If a majority of Voters voting in the City's Election on October 4, 2022, approve the Proposition, the Mayor will sign this Ordinance and the Clerk will attest and certify the passage and adoption of this Ordinance at the Certification of Election to be held October 10, 2022

**THIS IS TO CERTIFY** that on the 4<sup>th</sup>, day of October 2022, the City of Thorne Bay, Alaska, held a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing a registered voter to City Council Seats A & B for a term of 3 years and vote on one Ballot Initiative that would set term limits on the office of City Council for not more than 6 consecutive years.

As confirmed by the Thorne Bay City Council, upon completion of the final canvass of ballots on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 2022, final election results are:

**Seat A: (3-Year Term)**

Robert D. Hartwell – 81 votes

**With a vote of 81, Robert Hartwell is hereby elected to City Council Seat A for a term of 3-years**

**Seat B: (3-Year Term)**

Charles Jennings – 69 votes

Tiana Lavoie – 35 votes

**With a vote of 69, Charles Jennings is hereby elected to City Council Seat B for a term of 3-years**

**Ballot Initiative:**

Shall an ordinance be adopted by the City to establish term limits for the office of City Council, limiting one person to serve no more than six consecutive years in office.

Yes – 53 votes

No – 51 votes


**With a vote of 53, Ballot Initiative has passed, establishing a term limit of not more than 6 consecutive years in office.**
